Statistics to share.....

- 48,592 patrons visited us in 2012.
- 148,980 items were borrowed.
- 19,335 items were shared to and from other Monroe County Libraries on inter-library loan
- 1176 eBooks were downloaded.
- 6 Museum passes were borrowed.
- 3827 new items were purchased.
- 3,687 children attended 180 programs.
- 239 young adults attended 10 programs.
- 572 adults attended 38 programs.
- 143 patrons attended 7 family programs.
- 285 days of service in 2012
- 156 community groups used our meeting room

New & Improved Services in 2012.....

Overdrive expanded holdings

- In 2012, Ogden library contributed 4% of its materials budget to the Monroe County Library System for new titles for the library system's Overdrive collection for e-reader owners
- As a result, OFL holdings available through Overdrive for e-readers almost doubled!
