**Friends Treasurer's Report:** Savings: \$7523.93, Checking: \$1789.75, Total: \$9313.68. \$1000.00 has been set aside for two \$500.00 scholarships.

The scholarship application will be open to people who have a connection to the library; a member of the Junior Friends, a volunteer, a staff member. The students will write a 500 word essay explaining their goals, career decisions and how they could benefit humanity. Spelling and grammar will count. The selection committee will begin taking applications in January and decide at the April meeting. The scholarship will be presented at the Award Ceremony at the High School in the spring.

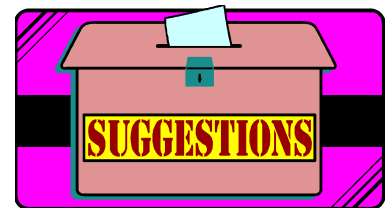
**News from the Ogden Farmers' Library.**
