CODE OF CONDUCT

Please:

- Enjoy your library!
- Switch cell phones off or put on vibrate, step outside to answer
- Properly check out your materials before leaving
- Supervise your children
- Pay for all printing and copying
- Wear proper attire including shirts and shoes
- Be respectful of others

Not permitted:

- Soliciting
- Smoking, use of e-cigarettes, or use of any alternative smoking methods
- Using, distributing or being under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol
- Use of restrooms other than for intended purpose
- Harassment and/or profanity
- Disruptive, disorderly, harassing or hazardous behavior
- Destroying, defacing, tampering or theft of library materials, property or equipment
- Improper computer use including displaying inappropriate and/or offensive images
- Loud conversations and noises which disrupt others

All patrons are required to obey all safety and security rules at the library, including such things as, but not limited to, the use of PPE while in the library. Safety and security rules may be permanent or temporary, and will be presented on signage at the entrance and throughout the library.

All patrons must comply with the Online Code of Conduct posted at all computer workstations and the Internet Protection Act.

Patrons will be held responsible for any damage to library property or equipment.

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may lead to eviction and possible discontinuation of Library privileges.
